With security as my portfolio, I am quite distressed to hear about and see that we have vigilante-type behaviour taking place along Peninsula Road. It is one thing being in a reflective vest and stopping traffic to allow an endangered species of toad, crab or even some ducklings to cross the road to safety, but quite another to leap into the road waving arms frantically to slow down a vehicle that is perceived to be speeding.
